As it happens I only need to keep one (and it's the only one that has useful resources that I've been using), but it would be good to be able to view a list of deleted projects again. I can't find any way to do this - the best I've been able to do is restore my "admin" project, which isn't helpful to me. Is there a way to restore a project, or view my deleted projects in some other way? A: You can't restore a project, and there is no way to see your deleted projects (they are gone forever, as you found out). You can always create a new project with the same name and description and then copy all the content over to it. Then, this will be your new "deleted" project, and you can then use the "admin" project to copy it's contents back into the deleted one. If you do this, then the "admin" project will continue to show that project's contents in the Projects list, and you'll be able to restore 82157476af
